CLEANING PROTOCOLS



Each day the following Education areas will be cleaned and disinfected before the start of the day and then disinfected between classes:

Frequently touched surfaces such as countertops, doorknobs, stair railings, restroom fixtures, stall handles, any touch dispensers and light switches.

Hand Sanitizer dispensers will be available in the classrooms and other public areas.



No-touch soap and paper towel dispensers in restrooms will be fully stocked.

IF STUDENT IS SICK

Students should stay home and notify their teachers when they are sick. If a student feels ill during a class, the teacher will have the final decision, based on the symptoms, whether to allow them to stay for the class.

If a student begins to experience any COVID-19 health issues, they will immediately be sent to a separate designated room and we will notify their parents immediately.



Students who are well but who have a sick family member at home with COVID-19 should remain home. At home, parents should conduct a personal risk assessment. If a student is confirmed to have COVID-19, we will inform all staff, and students in contact with the infected person through phone calls, group emails, or group texts immediately. The infected person's name will not be mentioned, but the confirmation of COVID will be revealed.

Note: We will follow all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations on confidentiality.

CLASS ARRIVAL



Parking: Parents, drivers, and caretakers will not be allowed to enter the building. They may wait in their cars in the parking lot or sit outside on theatre grounds.

Prior to the start of each class, teachers will meet their students at the following entrances:

Theatre Students: Lobby doors of 120 - 124 Market House Square

Dance Students: 206 - 208 KY Avenue doors

HEALTHY IN CLASS

Staff and teaching assistants will be wearing clear face shields or masks to protect students before and during class.



At The Start of Class We Will:

- Conduct a no-touch temperature check
- Ask simple health questions
- Provide hand sanitizer or hand-washing stations



During Class We Will:

- Maintain a 6-foot distance between others.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough or sneeze into your elbow or use a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Use a larger social distance if needed (to account for movement.).

At The End Of Class We Will:

- Provide students with hand sanitizer or send students to hand washing station before being released from the building.



TUITION CREDITS

Students asked to go home because they are ill or are suspected of having become exposed to COVID-19 will be considered for a refund or credit of tuition as per policy. Market House Theatre will review appeals to this policy and offer credits to additional classes or workshops on a case by case basis. We do not require a note from a healthcare provider for students who are ill to validate their health or return to classes unless they have been diagnosed with COVID-19.
